A Note from Treasurer Bill Howlin:

I would like to remind the members that the membership dues for flying year 2021 will increase on the 1st of January to \$120.00 per year. This is an increase of \$3.50 per month. This increase is partly due to the decline in membership and the yearly increase in our lease fee and the anticipated costs of repairs to our facility.

Meeting Minutes / October 2020

- Meeting called to order at 0900 on Saturday, October 17th, 2020. Present was club president Jeremy Wehner. In attendance was roughly 10 members.
- Discussion was held on old business: the runway maintenance project has been tabled until Spring 2021.
- Officer elections were held; Jeremy Wehner remains President, Mike Feitinger was elected as Vice President, Bill Howlin remains Treasurer. Steve Graham was to be asked to remain as Safety Officer.
- Membership dues were voted to be increased to \$120 per year, a \$3.50 per month increase. Membership decline and property lease increases were listed as the reasons for the needed increase. With this increase there will not be an initial runway assessment with a new membership.
- A safety issue was brought up, better communication of aircraft movements needs to be made (i.e.- calling on the runway, taking off, landing, etc.). See below for more information.
- Meeting adjourned at approximately 0930.
