SAFETY TIMEOUT

"CONSUMER WARNING"

Hello Flyers! In a previous newsletter, I wrote a brief article about "Prop Safety". I think a lot of you had flashbacks when you got nicked by a prop, I know I did. Last weekend I was cleaning out my tool bag that I take out to the field and found this label inside that I had torn off from a new prop package.

ever read the warning? To be honest, I do not remember ever reading it. I know props can be dangerous...I've been "bit" before! Here is what it says: to properly use, maintain, or operate this propeller may result in serious injury. Refer to the engine manufacturer for proper size propeller. Install flat side of prop towards engine. Tighten prop nut securely. Do not let spinner touch prop blades. Use electric starter or chicken stick to start engine. Keep fingers, hands, hair, and clothing out of path of prop. Make all adjustments from behind engine. Keep all spectators 20 feet from path of prop. Do not start engine in loose dirt or gravel. To stop engine, shut off fuel supply. DO NOT THROW ANYTHING INTO PROPELLER TO STOP ENGINE! Discard props with fractures, nicks, or signs of wear. Do not repair or modify this propeller in any matter.

Lessons learned; Read the label...do not get complacent! Stay focus when installing props onto your engine in that it is facing correctly. Stay safe when starting your engine, secure all loose items nearby, including your radio lanyard around your neck.
