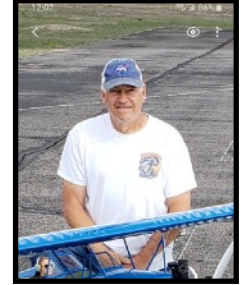

Safety “Awareness”

Safety is an attitude, a frame of mind. Safety is not an activity for participation only when one is being watched or supervised. It is the conscious awareness of one’s environment and actions all day, everyday. *Doing* Safety is doing the right stuff all the time... at work, at play and in your home life. All it requires is common sense and a reasonable willingness to see, hear, smell and THINK.

The AMA and MAS has processes and tools in place to eliminate hazards as much as is possible but members play the most crucial role in their own safety. Some of the significant contributing factors leading to injury and damage to model aircraft and property are:

- Rushing
- Frustration
- Fatigue
- Complacency

-which have caused these critical errors:

- Mind not on task
- Eyes not on task
- Moving into or being in the line-of-fire
- Loss of balance, traction or grip

Think about your own experiences on the job, off the job, or while driving. Have you ever experienced a “close call” or hurt yourself in some way without one or more of these factors contributing to the error? My bet is that you’ll have a hard time relating a personal example that falls outside these patterns.

If you aren't looking at what you're doing and you're not thinking about what you're doing, all the specific hazard training in the world won't do you any good at that moment... and you become the hazard – to yourself and your fellow team members.

Safety doesn't just happen, make it happen
